

ECT and Mentor Processes and Guides

The Course:

- ECTs complete a 2-year ECF course to accompany the 2-year induction period.
- Mentors complete a 2-year ECF course alongside the ECT.
- Tudor Grange Academy Teaching School Hub is the 'delivery partner' who co-ordinates your course on behalf of Education Development Trust (EDT), a DfE-accredited lead provider.
- ECTs and Mentors will belong to a cohort depending on when they start their course (e.g. September 2022 or April 2023).
- It is essential you know your cohort to ensure you follow your course correctly and complete correct learning and attend correct events.

The Online Platform:

- If you are on a standard contract, you are expected to complete 2 blocks per term.
- This is a DfE requirement.

- ✎ You must sign up to your events on the online platform here: [event calendar](#).
- ✎ You may be allocated a group at the beginning of your course depending on your cohort.
- ✎ It is unfortunately not possible to change group unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- ✎ It is important to attend the correct event for your group to ensure continuity of provision and to also ensure the number of attendees is manageable for venues.
- ✎ If for whatever reason you cannot attend an event, it is important you view the catch-up materials on the platform. These will be emailed to you after the event.

School Reminders:

- ✎ You should have an allocated mentor to support you one-to-one.
- ✎ You should have a weekly (in year 1) or fortnightly (in year 2) mentor meeting.
- ✎ The school should have an allocated induction tutor to oversee your induction and the ECF provision.
- ✎ Please direct initial queries to your mentor/induction tutor.

Please Notify us as soon as possible if there are changes in your role including:

- ✎ You are moving schools.
- ✎ You are on extended leave (maternity/paternity/sick).
- ✎ You are leaving the profession.
- ✎ You have a change of mentor.
- ✎ You have a change in your induction (reduced/extended).
- ✎ Your contract changes (part-time/full-time).
