#### The Role:

The induction tutor is responsible for the following:

- Overseeing the induction of ECTs and co-ordinating an internal programme of development.
- Overseeing the role of mentors.
- Monitoring the engagement and progress of ECTs and Mentors on the online platform.
- Liaising with Tudor Grange Teaching School Hub and engaging in our support systems.
- Notifying Tudor Grange Teaching School Hub of any changes and updates.
- Completing quality assurance internally.
- Completing assessments and progress reviews on ECT Manager (appropriate body).
